1. What is ASPIRE?

2. Who can enroll in ASPIRE?

Children diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), aged 3–18 years, can enroll. Programs are tailored according to each child's developmental level, learning style, and abilities.

3. What makes ASPIRE different from regular online schools?

- Individualized learning plans for every child
- Support from trained special educators and therapists
- Structured routines and interactive activities to improve communication, behavior, and academics
